Biography

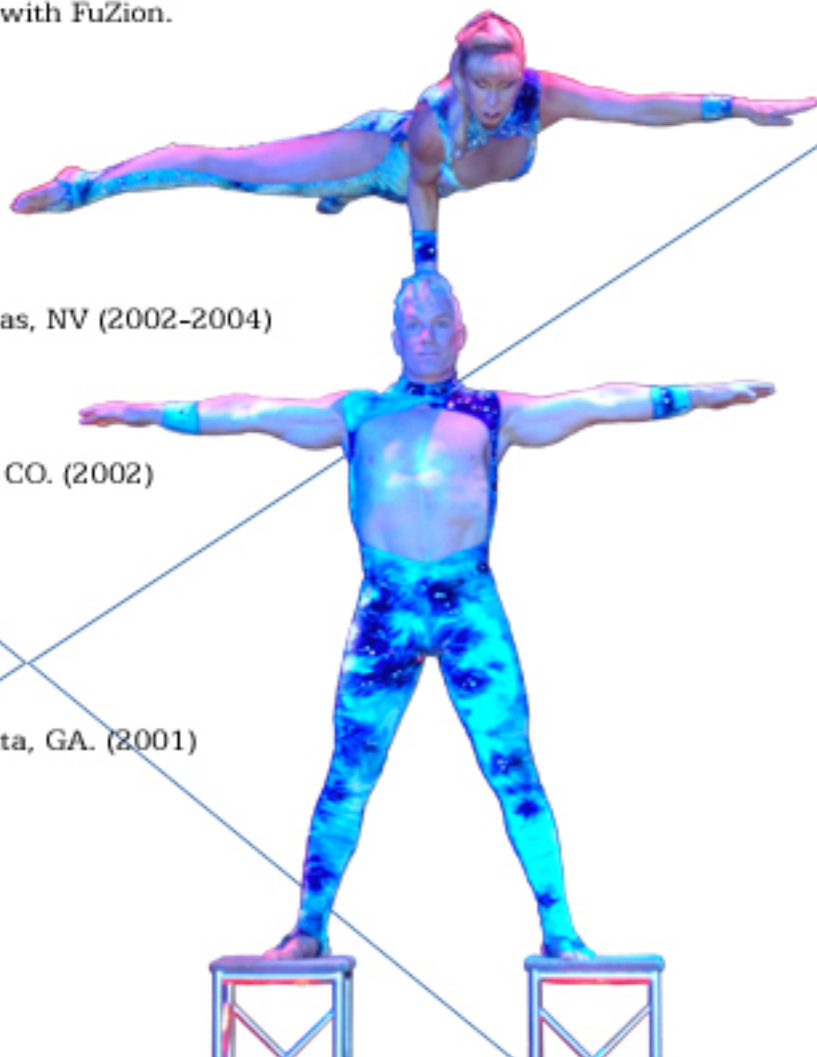
FuZion's inherent ability to inspire and motivate audiences comes from years of performance experience and extensive training.

Joni-K, 5'3", 115lbs. a former competitive gymnast whose professional background spans over twenty years, toured Africa, Europe, The Middle East, The Caribbean, New Zealand and the U.S.A. in a variety of acts highlighting acro-handbalancing adagio and sport acrobatics. The Performance

The act is very versatile and can run from two (2) to ten (10) minutes in length and be performed with or without the prop using one (1) to all five (5) pedestals. In addition, a variety of costumes can be used including marble-style body paint. If you have a special theme for your event, FuZion can perform to any soundtrack and create a unique balancing act to suit your needs.

Height Requirements

FuZion's staging needs are flexible and can accommodate any theatrical or convention space. However, below are some desired stage dimensions.

(Floor Routine)

- Width of stage: 6 feet
 - Depth of stage: 6 feet
 - Height of stage: Any, 3 feet is better for viewing when audience is seated.
 - Height required between stage and ceiling: 12 feet minimum
- Smaller rooms with less than 12' high ceilings may require performance adjustments.

(Prop Routine)

- Width of stage: 8 feet
 - Depth of stage: 8 feet
 - Height of stage: Any
 - Height required between stage and ceiling: 16 feet minimum
- Smaller rooms with less than 16' high ceilings may require performance and prop adjustments.

Prop Technical Info and Specifications

Onsite transport needs:

1 four caster platform truck dolly with a deck size of at least 2 ½' x 5'.

Assemble time:

1 hour, once in the staging area (complete prop with all five pedestals).

FuZion will supply the tools for assembly.

Dimensions:

Prop assembled height: 4 feet

Base: 5 feet wide x 5 feet deep x 10 inches high with (4) casters that retract into the base.

Pedestals: (2) 3 feet high rear, (2) 2 feet high front, (1) 1 foot high middle. All have 12" square surface. Each pedestal is lighted from the base.
